Whether a child or adolescent presents with emotional disturbance, multiple disabilities, speech and language impairments, or other health impairments, including TBI or neurologic impairment, our residential and day programs can help.

NeuroRestorative Academies provide dynamic learning opportunities in a supported, fun, and innovative environment in state-of-the-art school buildings. We have a low teacher-to-student ratio, ensuring personalized attention on each student. The schools are approved/ registered or certified by states as a non-public residential facility.


